Humane Society - Repeal of Written Notice to Inspect

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that a humane society must send a
- 4 certain written notice prior to making an inspection of certain premises and
- 5 kennels to determine if there is inhumane treatment of dogs; and generally
- 6 relating to the right of a humane society to inspect certain premises and kennels
- 7 to determine if there is inhumane treatment of dogs.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

16 67A.

- 17 Any authorized director of a State-chartered humane society when accompanied
- 18 by a sheriff or one of his deputies[, after having given prior written notice of the time
- 19 and date to the owners or occupants of the premises,] may visit and inspect the
- 20 premises where any person is engaged in the business of buying, selling, trading, or
- 21 breeding dogs, or the premises of any kennels where twenty-five or more dogs are
- 22 kept, for the purpose of determining if there is inhumane treatment of dogs therein
- 23 which is prohibited by this subtitle or any other applicable law. This section does not
- 24 apply to any premises (1) on which the keeping or breeding of dogs is solely for the
- 25 purpose of medical or related research or laboratory tests; (2) operated by a licensed
- 26 and regularly practicing veterinarian; or (3) on which hunting dogs, are housed, if the
- 27 buying, selling, trading or breeding is incidental to the main purposes of housing,
- 28 keeping and using dogs. In Baltimore City the provisions of this section shall be
- 29 enforced by the Baltimore City Health Department. In Baltimore County, the

- provisions of this section shall be enforced by the Baltimore County Bureau of Animal
 Control or by an organization approved by the Baltimore County government.
- 3 SECTIO 4 July 1, 2001. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
