2 Workers' Compensation - Self-Insurance Groups - Guaranty Fund

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing certain obligations for certain workers' compensation
- 4 self-insurance groups; altering certain procedures in the event of a certain
- 5 insolvency; authorizing the Insurance Commissioner to exempt a certain group
- from a certain assessment under certain circumstances; providing that a certain
- 7 assessment does not relieve a certain group member of certain obligations;
- 8 requiring the Commissioner to take certain actions in the event of a certain
- 9 assessment; and generally relating to workers' compensation self-insurance
- 10 groups.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - Insurance

- 19 25-304.
- 20 (a) Before a self-insurance group may operate, the self-insurance group must
- 21 obtain the approval of the Commissioner, including approval of its self-insurance
- 22 agreement.
- 23 (b) Each self-insurance group must have combined net assets of at least
- 24 \$1,000,000.
- 25 (C) (1) A SELF-INSURANCE GROUP SHALL PAY ALL WORKERS'
- 26 COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR WHICH EACH MEMBER INCURS LIABILITY DURING
- 27 ITS PERIOD OF MEMBERSHIP.

- 1 (2) EACH MEMBER OF A SELF-INSURANCE GROUP IS JOINTLY AND
- 2 SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION OBLIGATIONS OF THE
- 3 GROUP AND ITS MEMBERS THAT ARE INCURRED DURING ITS PERIOD OF
- 4 MEMBERSHIP.
- 5 (3) A MEMBER WHO ELECTS TO TERMINATE ITS MEMBERSHIP IN OR IS
- 6 CANCELED BY A GROUP REMAINS JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY LIABLE FOR WORKERS'
- 7 COMPENSATION OBLIGATIONS OF THE GROUP AND ITS MEMBERS WHICH WERE
- 8 INCURRED DURING THE CANCELED OR TERMINATED MEMBER'S PERIOD OF
- 9 MEMBERSHIP.
- 10 (4) THE INSOLVENCY OR BANKRUPTCY OF A MEMBER DOES NOT
- 11 RELIEVE THE SELF-INSURANCE GROUP OR ANY OTHER MEMBER OF LIABILITY FOR
- 12 THE PAYMENT OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS INCURRED DURING THE
- 13 INSOLVENT OR BANKRUPT MEMBER'S PERIOD OF MEMBERSHIP.

- 15 (a) A self-insurance group is not liable for payments to the Property and
- 16 Casualty Insurance Guaranty Corporation.
- 17 (b) There is a Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund.
- 18 (c) The Uninsured Employers' Fund established under § 10-304 of the Labor
- 19 and Employment Article shall administer the Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund.
- 20 (d) (1) IN THE EVENT THAT A SELF-INSURANCE GROUP BECOMES
- 21 INSOLVENT, THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND, ON BEHALF OF THE
- 22 SELF-INSURERS' GUARANTY FUND, SHALL ASSESS EACH SELF-INSURANCE GROUP
- 23 BASED ON THE PROPORTION THAT THE PREMIUM OF EACH GROUP BEARS TO THE
- 24 TOTAL PREMIUM OF ALL SELF-INSURANCE GROUPS.
- 25 (2) THE COMMISSIONER MAY EXEMPT A SELF-INSURANCE GROUP FROM
- 26 ASSESSMENT IF THE COMMISSIONER DETERMINES THAT PAYMENT OF THE
- 27 ASSESSMENT WOULD RENDER THE GROUP INSOLVENT.
- 28 (3) AN ASSESSMENT LEVIED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT
- 29 RELIEVE ANY MEMBER OF AN INSOLVENT GROUP OF ITS JOINT AND SEVERAL
- 30 LIABILITY. [Each self-insurance group shall pay an assessment into the
- 31 Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund at the same level assessed against other workers'
- 32 compensation insurers by the Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty
- 33 Corporation under Title 9, Subtitle 3 of this article.]
- 34 (E) IF AN ASSESSMENT IS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (D) OF
- 35 THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:
- 36 (1) TAKE ACTION TO ENFORCE THE MEMBERS' OBLIGATIONS UNDER §
- 37 25-304(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 38 (2) RECOUP FROM THE INSOLVENT GROUP'S MEMBERS:

- 1 (I) ALL COSTS INCURRED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN ENFORCING
 2 THE JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY OBLIGATIONS; AND
 3 (II) AMOUNTS THAT THE COMMISSIONER ASSESSED EACH OTHER
 4 SELF-INSURANCE GROUP IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
 5 [(e)] (F) [(1) The Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund shall pay any outstanding
 6 obligations of a self-insurance group that becomes insolvent.
- 7 (2)] If the Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund becomes insolvent, any 8 outstanding obligations of an insolvent self-insurance group are a joint and several
- 9 liability of each member of the self-insurance group.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2001.
