BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 6 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10-101(f) through (aa), respectively, of Article - Natural 7 Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8 10-101(g) through (bb), respectively. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 10 read as follows: 11 **Article - Natural Resources** 12 10-101. 13 (E) (1) "FEDERAL FACILITY" MEANS FEDERAL LAND IN THE STATE. 14 "FEDERAL FACILITY" INCLUDES MILITARY BASES, NATIONAL (2) 15 WILDLIFE REFUGES, AND UNITS OF THE NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM. "Forest game birds and mammals" means forest game birds (ruffed 16 [(e)] (F) grouse and turkey) and forest game mammals (black bears, deer, fox squirrels, 18 excluding the Delmarva subspecies, and gray and red squirrels) or any part, egg, 19 offspring, or dead body of any of them. 20 10-409. [Pursuant to] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 21 (A)22 SECTION, UNDER § 10-205 of this title, the Department shall establish and publish by 23 April 25 each year the bag limits per day for game birds and mammals by regulation 24 for the ensuing year. The bag limits for ducks, geese, brant, railbirds, woodcock, 25 mergansers, doves, and snipe may conform to the federal migratory bird rules and 26 regulations adopted annually by the Secretary of Interior of the United States. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO BAG LIMITS FOR DEER HUNTING ON A 27 (B) 28 FEDERAL FACILITY. 29 10-415. 30 (a) There are the following 3 seasons to hunt deer: 31 (1) Deer bow hunting season; 32 (2) Deer firearms season; and 33 (3)Deer muzzle loader season.

| | (3) (i) The Department may issue a limited number of bonus antlerless deer stamps for the purpose of regulating the harvest of antlerless deer in a particular deer management region or zone. |

| 11 | (iii) The fee is nonrefundable if the applicant does not obtain an antlerless deer stamp. If an individual obtains a bonus antlerless deer stamp, the application fee for the stamp will be applied to the fee for the stamp and no additional stamp fee will be required. |
| 15 16 17 18 | (e) A person may not remove the head or hide or any part from any deer, except internal organs, or cut the meat into parts until the deer has been checked by the Department or 1 of the Department's agents at a designated checking station. Removal of the head or the hide of any deer not checked at a designated checking station shall be prima facie evidence that the deer was hunted illegally. Each separate deer or part of any deer taken illegally or found in possession shall be considered a separate offense. |
| 22 23 24 25 | (f) Any person who, while operating a motor vehicle on any highway in the State, accidentally strikes and kills a deer on the highway may have the deer if the person produces visible evidence of collision with the deer to any Natural Resources police officer, State law enforcement officer, or other designated representative of the Secretary. The provisions of this subsection shall be applicable to deer killed by collision with a motor vehicle at any time whether during the open season for killing deer or during the legally closed season. |

| | (h) The Department shall establish antlered and antlerless deer hunting requirements in each deer management region to meet the goals of the Deer Management Plan. |
