A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Baltimore City Eubie Blake National Jazz
 3 Institute and Cultural Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$800,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Eubie Blake
- 6 National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center, Inc. for certain development or
- 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund;
- 9 requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland
- Historical Trust; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds
- 11 evidencing the loan.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 15 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 16 City Eubie Blake National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center Loan of 2001 in a
- 17 total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$800,000 or (ii) the amount of the
- 18 matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be
- 19 evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 20 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 21 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 22 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 23 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 24 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 25 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 26 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 27 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 28 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 29 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 30 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 31 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Eubie Blake
- 32 National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as

- 1 "the grantee") for the acquisition of a new building, and for the renovation, repair,
- 2 reconstruction, and capital equipping of the new building and the existing adjacent
- 3 building, for the Eubie Blake National Jazz Institute and Cultural Center, located on
- 4 North Howard Street in Baltimore, Maryland.
- 5 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 6 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 7 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 8 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 9 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 10 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 11 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 12 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 13 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 14 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 15 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 16 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 17 The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 18 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 19 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 20 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 21 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 22 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 23 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 24 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 25 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 26 its interest:
- 27 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 28 and
- 29 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 30 structures.
- 31 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 32 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 June 1, 2001.
