1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Task Force to Study the Health Care Needs of Inmates in Transition from**
3 **Correctional Institutions**

4 FOR the purpose of extending the time by which the Task Force to Study the Health
5 Care Needs of Inmates in Transition from Correctional Institutions is required
6 to report to the General Assembly; amending Chapter 466 of the Acts of 2000;
7 extending a certain termination date that applies to the Task Force; and
8 generally relating to the Task Force to Study the Health Care Needs of Inmates
9 in Transition from Correctional Institutions.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments**

22 (g) The Task Force shall issue a final report of its findings, recommendations,
23 and comprehensive strategy to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State
24 Government Article, to the General Assembly on or before [December 31, 2001] JUNE

Chapter 466 of the Acts of 2000

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
3 July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year and 6 months] 2 YEARS
4 and, at the end of [December 31, 2001] JUNE 30, 2002, with no further action required
5 by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and
6 effect.
