16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 (b) Subject to the provisions of subsection (d) of this section, the Commission 21 shall assess a fee on:

- 22 (1) All hospitals;
- 23 (2) All nursing homes;
- 24 (3) All payors; and
- 25 (4) All health care practitioners.

1 (c) (1) The total fees assessed by the Commission may not exceed 2 [\$8,250,000] \$10,000,000 in any fiscal year.

3 (2) The fees assessed by the Commission shall be used exclusively to 4 cover the actual documented direct costs of fulfilling the statutory and regulatory 5 duties of the Commission in accordance with the provisions of this subtitle.

6 (3) The Commission shall pay all funds collected from the fees assessed 7 in accordance with this section into the Fund.

8 (4) The fees assessed may be expended only for purposes authorized by 9 the provisions of this subtitle.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2001.

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
