1 AN ACT concerning

2 Resident Consolidated Senior Lifetime Sport Fishing License

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a resident consolidated senior lifetime sport fishing
- 4 license; establishing the fee for the license and the means by which the license
- 5 may be obtained; <u>authorizing an agent to retain a certain amount of the fee as</u>
- 6 compensation for each license issued; establishing the rights of a holder of the
- 7 license; providing that fees collected by the Department of Natural Resources in
- 8 connection with this license may be used only for certain purposes; and
- 9 generally relating to the resident consolidated senior lifetime sport fishing
- 10 license.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Natural Resources
- 19 4-217.
- 20 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A RESIDENT CONSOLIDATED
- 21 SENIOR LIFETIME SPORT FISHING LICENSE TO BE ISSUED TO RESIDENTS OF
- 22 MARYLAND BEGINNING IN THE CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THEY BECOME 65 YEARS
- 23 OF AGE.

- 1 (B) (1) THE RESIDENT CONSOLIDATED SENIOR LIFETIME SPORT FISHING 2 LICENSE MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OR FROM ANY AUTHORIZED 3 AGENT OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4 (2) THE ONE-TIME FEE FOR THE LICENSE IS \$12.50 \(\frac{\$25}{} \).
- 5 (3) AS COMPENSATION, AN AGENT SHALL RETAIN 50 CENTS 1.50 FOR 6 EACH LICENSE ISSUED.
- 7 (C) A RESIDENT CONSOLIDATED SENIOR LIFETIME SPORT FISHING LICENSE 8 SHALL BE VALID FOR THE DURATION OF THE LIFETIME OF THE HOLDER.
- 9 (D) A HOLDER OF A RESIDENT CONSOLIDATED SENIOR LIFETIME SPORT 10 FISHING LICENSE MAY:
- 11 (1) ENGAGE IN ANGLING ON THE NONTIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE 12 WITHOUT HOLDING AN ANGLER'S LICENSE UNDER § 4-604 OF THIS TITLE;
- 13 (2) ENGAGE IN ANGLING FOR TROUT ON THE NONTIDAL WATERS OF 14 THE STATE WITHOUT HOLDING A TROUT STAMP UNDER § 4-614 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- 15 (3) FISH FOR FINFISH IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TRIBUTARIES 16 WITHOUT HOLDING A CHESAPEAKE BAY SPORT FISHING LICENSE UNDER § 4-745 OF 17 THIS TITLE.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2001.
