BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Education** 17 18-601. 18 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 19 "Disabled public safety employee" means a State or local public safety 20 employee who sustains an injury in the line of duty that: Precludes the individual from continuing to serve or be 21 22 employed as a State or local public safety employee; and 23 (ii) In the case of a volunteer member of a fire department or 24 ambulance or rescue company or squad, precludes the member from continuing to be 25 employed in the nonpublic safety occupation in which the member is engaged at the 26 time of the injury.

"Surviving spouse" means a person who has not remarried.
