3 FOR the purpose of providing that, in addition to any other information required to be 4 displayed, certain vehicle registration plates may display the name of the 5 county, including Baltimore City, in which the vehicle's registered owner resides; 6 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to offer to each vehicle owner 7 applying for new or replacement registration plates the option to obtain a 8 sticker that affixes to the registration plates and displays the owner's county of 9 residence; requiring the Administration to approve a sticker design option that 10 complies with this Act; authorizing the Administration, in addition to the annual

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this title, when it registers a vehicle, 4 the Administration shall issue to the owner:

(1) Each registration plate shall display:
(III) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.
(2) AT THE OPTION OF THE REGISTERED OWNER OF A VEHICLE FOR WHICH REGISTRATION PLATES ARE ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE, IN ADDITION TO THE INFORMATION OTHERWISE REQUIRED TO BE SHOWN ON THE REGISTRATION PLATES, THE REGISTRATION PLATES MAY DISPLAY A STICKER INDICATING THE
(3) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
(I) APPROVE A STICKER DESIGN OPTION THAT COMPLIES WITH
(II) OFFER TO EACH VEHICLE OWNER APPLYING FOR NEW OR 30 REPLACEMENT REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS TITLE THE OPTION TO SELECT A 31 STICKER THAT DISPLAYS THE OWNER'S COUNTY OF RESIDENCE.

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(4) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE 33 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHARGE A FEE, NOT TO

1 EXCEED ITS COSTS, FOR ISSUING OR REPLACING THE COUNTY STICKER OFFERED
2 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

## 3 (5) A VEHICLE OWNER MAY NOT DISPLAY STICKERS THAT SHOW A

 4 COUNTY NAME OTHER THAN THE OWNER'S COUNTY OF RESIDENCE.5 (6) A COUNTY STICKER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE 6 PLACED ON A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE OR A COMMEMORATIVE REGISTRATION 7 PLATE ISSUED UNDER SUBTITLE 6 OF THIS TITLE.
$8 \quad[(\mathrm{c})] \quad$ (D) Registration plates may be reflectorized and shall be manufactured of 9 a material warranted to have a durability of at least 5 years. However, prior to
10 registration plates being reflectorized, the Administration shall obtain approval of the
11 General Assembly through a budget item.
12 [(d)] (E) (1) During subsequent registration years, the Administrator may 13 order the continued use of registration plates that are valid during any current
14 registration year, and, after so doing, the Administrator shall issue, at the time a
15 vehicle's registration is renewed, a validation tab to evidence payment of the vehicle's
16 annual registration fee.
17 (2) The tab shall be displayed on the plates of the vehicle in the manner 18 that the Administrator requires.

19 (3) The Administrator from time to time shall evaluate the condition of 20 registration plates issued under this title and may provide for the manufacture and
21 issuance of new registration plates. These new registration plates shall be issued and
22 subsequently validated in the manner required by this subtitle.
23 [(e)] (F) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c) of this section, the
24 Administration may issue reflectorized registration plates under §§ 13-618 and
25 13-619 of this title.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2001.
