- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 21 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 22 12-107.
- 23 (b) (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink on the licensed premises
- 24 of any license holder any alcoholic beverages not purchased from the license holder on
- 25 said premises and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the premises; and
- 26 it shall be unlawful for any license holder to permit any person to drink any alcoholic
- 27 beverage not purchased from the said license holder on the premises covered by the

- 1 license which he holds and not permitted by this article to be consumed on the
- 2 premises.
- 3 (6) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO SPECIAL LICENSES ISSUED
- 4 IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY TO ANY BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC,
- $5\,$  VETERANS, HOSPITAL, OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION UNDER  $\S$  7-101(R) OF THIS
- 6 ARTICLE.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 2001.
