14 15	(a) Unless otherwise provided by law, a custodian shall deny inspection of a public record, as provided in this section.
18 19 20 21	(m) (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection, a custodian shall deny inspection of all photographs, videotapes or electronically recorded images of vehicles, vehicle movement records, personal financial information, credit reports, or other personal or financial data created, recorded, obtained by or submitted to the Maryland Transportation Authority or its agents or employees in connection with any electronic toll collection system OR ASSOCIATED TRANSACTION SYSTEM.
23 24	(2) A custodian shall permit inspection of the records enumerated in paragraph (1) of this subsection by:
25	(i) an individual named in the record;
26	(ii) the attorney of record of an individual named in the record; [or]

- 7 ADMINISTRATION, ITS AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR CONTRACTORS.
