- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION OF NOT LESS THAN
- 19 \$20 MILLION IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 FOR THE MARYLAND
- 20 AFTER-SCHOOL OPPORTUNITY FUND.
- 21 (B) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL DISBURSE \$10 MILLION OF THE
- 22 AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 23 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 24 (C) (1) TEN MILLION DOLLARS OF THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE
- 25 FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 SHALL BE DISBURSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE

- 1 (2) EACH RECIPIENT OF FUNDS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL 2 PROVIDE AND EXPEND A MATCHING FUND EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS THAT

- 4 (3) THE TOTAL GRANTS AWARDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO ALL
- 5 THE RECIPIENTS IN ANY COUNTY, INCLUDING BALTIMORE CITY, MAY NOT EXCEED
- 6 \$2,500,000.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
