BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments** 18 19 404. 20 (a) (1) In this subheading the following words have the meanings indicated. 21 (2)**(I)** "Tobacco product" means any substance containing tobacco, 22 including cigarettes, cigars, smoking tobacco, snuff, or smokeless tobacco. "TOBACCO PRODUCT" INCLUDES A FLAVORED TOBACCO-BASED 23 (II) 24 PRODUCT KNOWN AS A BIDI CIGARETTE.

 (d) In a prosecution for a violation of subsection (b)(1) or (2) of this section, it shall be a defense that the defendant examined the purchaser's or recipient's driver's license or other valid identification issued by an employer, a governmental entity, or institution of higher education that positively identified the purchaser or recipient as at least 18 years old.

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1 (b) For purposes of this section, a violation of the provisions of this section is 2 deemed a Code violation and is a civil offense.

3 (c) An individual who violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to 4 the procedures and dispositions provided in Title 3, Subtitle 8 of the Courts and 5 Judicial Proceedings Article.

6 (d) A law enforcement officer authorized to make arrests shall issue a citation 7 to a person if the officer has probable cause to believe that the child is committing or 8 has committed a Code violation.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2001.
