The money in the Fund shall be used solely for:

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- 1 Medically oriented functions of the Department of State Police, (1) 2 Special Operations Bureau, Aviation Division; 3 (2) The Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems; (3) The R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center at the University of 5 Maryland Medical System; 6 (4) The Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute; 7 The provision of grants under the State Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance (5) 8 Fund in accordance with the provisions of Article 38A, §§ 45A through 45D of the 9 Code; and 10 The Low Interest Revolving Loan Account under the Volunteer 11 Company Assistance Fund in accordance with the provisions of Article 38A, §§ 46E 12 through 46H of the Code.
