20 21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
22	Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

24	(a) (1) This section applies only in Prince George's County.
	(2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A TRANSFER OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE INCLUDES A CHANGE IN THE OWNERSHIP OF MORE THAN THE CUMULATIVE AMOUNT OF 50% OF THE STOCK IN AN ESTABLISHMENT SINCE THE

- $1\,$  ESTABLISHMENT WAS ISSUED A NEW LICENSE OR WAS GRANTED AN EXISTING
- 2 LICENSE BY TRANSFER.
- 3 (h) An alcoholic beverage license with an off-sale privilege of any class, except
- 4 by way of renewal, may not be transferred or issued to any business establishment of
- 5 the type commonly known as chain stores, supermarkets, discount houses or their
- 6 franchisors and franchisees or concessionaires. However, those establishments
- 7 holding an alcoholic beverage license at the time of enactment of this section may
- 8 continue to hold such license, and may, at the discretion of the Board of License
- 9 Commissioners, change the classification of their license.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 11 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 12 on or application to any alcoholic beverages license transfer before the effective date
- 13 of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 October 1, 2001.
