1 AN ACT concerning

2 Education - Public Schools - Moment of Silence

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring public elementary and secondary schools to require all
- 4 students to meditate silently for a certain period of time each day; and generally
- 5 relating to a moment of silence in public schools in the State.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Education
- 14 7-104.
- 15 (a) [Principals and teachers in each public] PUBLIC elementary and
- 16 secondary [school] SCHOOLS in this State [may] SHALL require all students to be
- 17 present and participate in opening exercises on each morning of a school day and to
- 18 meditate silently for approximately 1 minute.
- 19 (b) During this period, a student or teacher may read the holy scripture or
- 20 pray.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 July 1, 2001.
