3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Garrett County dog warden and the warden's

- 4 deputies to enforce regulation of animals in Garrett County; authorizing the
- 5 Garrett County dog warden and the warden's deputies to issue a summons to
- 6 any person in violation of the regulation of animals in the county; authorizing
- 7 the County Commissioners of Garrett County to provide for a comprehensive
- 8 system for the regulation of dogs and cats in the county; and generally
- 9 pertaining to animal control in Garrett County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

- 18 11-504.
- 19 (a) (1) The sheriffs of the several counties, or any deputy authorized by him,
- 20 shall enforce the provisions of this subtitle. The sheriffs and their duly authorized
- 21 deputies may issue a summons to any person violating any provision of this subtitle.

1 (2) In Calvert County AND GARRETT COUNTY, the dog warden and his 2 deputies have the duties imposed by this subsection.

3 (3) This section does not apply in Washington County.

4 (o) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under this 5 subtile, the county commissioners of Dorchester, GARRETT, and Somerset Counties 6 may by ordinance provide for a comprehensive system for the regulation of dogs and 7 cats within the county, including licensing and control. These regulations may include 8 provision for the impounding and disposal of unlicensed or dangerous dogs and cats 9 and penalties for violations of any of the provisions of the regulations.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2001.
