BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 14 2-309. 15 (w) The Sheriff of Washington County shall receive a salary of [\$55,000] (1) 16 \$67,500. The Sheriff shall appoint a chief deputy at a salary level set by the County 17 Commissioners. The Sheriff may appoint deputy sheriffs and other personnel 18 necessary to perform the duties of office at salary levels set by the County 19 Commissioners in accordance with the County's budgetary process. 20 Any deputy sheriff appointed according to this section shall be placed 21 on a probationary status for the first year of his employment, and may be dismissed 22 by the Sheriff for any reason during that probationary period. At the conclusion of 23 twelve months' continuous employment, a deputy sheriff having the rank of

24 lieutenant or below has tenure, and may be discharged by the Sheriff only for

27 personnel needs, the County Commissioners may authorize a deputy sheriff to 28 perform off-duty services for any person who agrees to pay a fee, including but not

	(4) (i) The Sheriff of Washington County may appoint special deputy neriffs, including members of the police force of a Washington County municipality tho are:
7	1. Selected by the chief of police of the municipality; and
	2. Verified by the chief of police of the municipality as having chieved at least the minimum level of training for police duties in a municipality as lesignated by the Maryland Police Training Commission.
11 12	(ii) The appointment of special deputy sheriffs is subject to the following conditions:
	1. The Sheriff shall assign the special deputy sheriff who is a member of the police force to duties in the municipality where the special deputy sheriff is a member of the police force, or in the surrounding area;
	2. The Sheriff may terminate the appointment of the special deputy sheriff for cause or on completion of the assignment for which he was appointed;
19 20	3. The special deputy sheriff is not an employee of Washington County for the purpose of employment security or employee benefits; and
21 22	4. County liability insurance shall be provided to a special leputy sheriff only when he is acting within his official duties.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Washington County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
29 30	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
