1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article 1 - Rules of Interpretation

7	(A) In a law, resolution, or court order or decree that refers to publishing a legal advertisement or legal notice, words such as "paper", "newspaper", "newspaper in general circulation", or "newspaper devoted to the dissemination of general news" mean, unless otherwise provided, a publication that:
9	(1) Has at least 4 pages;
	(2) Habitually contains news items, reports of current events, editorial comments, advertising matter, and other miscellaneous information that is of public interest and is found generally in an ordinary newspaper;
	(3) At least once a week for 6 months or more before publication of the notice or advertisement, has been published and distributed, by sale, from an established place of business;
16 17	(4) Has general circulation throughout the community where the publication is published; and
18 19	(5) Is entitled to be entered as second-class matter in the United States mail.
	(B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION <u>AND FOR PURPOSES OF</u> <u>THE PUBLIC GENERAL LAWS OF THE STATE</u> , IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, "NEWSPAPER IN GENERAL CIRCULATION" <u>MEANS</u> <u>INCLUDES:</u>
