- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Transportation
- 15 8-651.
- 16 THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CONSTRUCT A SOUND BARRIER ON ANY
- 17 HIGHWAY UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION'S JURISDICTION IF THE COST TO
- 18 CONSTRUCT THE SOUND BARRIER WOULD EXCEED \$10,000 FOR EACH RESIDENCE
- 19 BENEFITED BY THE SOUND BARRIER.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 2001.
