- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Veterans' Commission and the Maryland
- Department of Veterans Affairs to conduct a study of the feasibility of 4
- 5 establishing a veterans' cemetery on the grounds of the former Bainbridge Naval
- 6 Training Center in Cecil County; providing for the matters to be included in the
- study; and requiring that the Commission and the Department report to the 7
- 8 appropriate committees of the General Assembly and the Cecil County
- 9 legislative delegation on the results of the study on or before a certain date.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - State Government**

- In this section, "State veterans' cemetery" means a cemetery that the 19 (a) (1)
- 20 Commission establishes under this section.
- 21 (2) In this section and in § 9-914 of this subtitle, "veteran" means an
- 22 individual who:
- served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States; 23 (i)
- 24 or
- 25 served as a member of the State militia ordered into active (ii)
- 26 service of the United States by order of the President and was killed in the line of
- 27 duty.
