- 3 (1) THE DESIGN OF A REGISTRATION PLATE TO BE ISSUED UNDER THIS
- 4 SECTION THAT SHOWS SUPPORT FOR AN EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION
- 5 INITIATIVE;
- 6 (2) THE SETTING OF THE FEE TO BE CHARGED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 7 (C)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION AT A LEVEL INTENDED TO ENCOURAGE THE PURCHASE OF
- 8 THE REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION WHILE PROVIDING A
- 9 CONTINUOUS REVENUE SOURCE TO BENEFIT THE TRUST; AND
- 10 (3) A SCHEDULE UNDER WHICH THE ADMINISTRATION WILL TRANSFER
- 11 TO THE TRUST REVENUE COLLECTED ON BEHALF OF THE TRUST.

- 15 General Assembly that the Motor Vehicle Administration work with the Early
- 16 Childhood Care and Education Trust on the development of a special registration
- 17 plate described under Section 1 of this Act and make the plate available to the public
- 18 at the earliest date practicable, but not later than July 1, 2002.
