A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County Sheriff's Office - Compensation**  
3 **PG 313-01**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the salaries for the chief assistant sheriff and the  
5 assistant sheriffs in Prince George's County; and generally relating to the  
6 salaries of the Prince George's County Sheriff's office.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
9 Section 2-309(r)(2) and (6)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1998 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 2-309.

16 (r) (2) (i) The Sheriff of Prince George's County shall be provided with 4  
17 full-time assistant sheriffs, and all assistant sheriffs shall be selected and appointed  
18 by the Sheriff and serve at the Sheriff's pleasure. One of the assistant sheriffs shall be  
19 appointed as the chief assistant sheriff. The assistant sheriffs shall be considered line  
20 officers, if so designated by the Sheriff.

21 (ii) Each assistant sheriff shall:

22 1. Be provided with an automobile for so long as they shall  
23 remain appointed assistant sheriff, for the use and work of the office of Sheriff, with  
24 adequate maintenance and insurance of the automobile to be at the expense of the  
25 County; and
