- 34 (3) THE INSPECTION OR, INSTALLATION, OR ADJUSTMENT OF THE
- 35 CHILD SAFETY SEAT, OR THE ADVICE OR ASSISTANCE, IS PROVIDED WITHOUT ANY
- 36 DIRECT OR INDIRECT FEE OR CHARGE TO THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE MOTOR

- 38 (4) THE INSPECTION, INSTALLATION, OR ADJUSTMENT OF THE CHILD
- 39 SAFETY SEAT IS NOT PROVIDED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE FOR PROFIT SALE OF
- 40 THE CHILD SAFETY SEAT.

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 2 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect3 on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

- 5 October 1, 2001.
