- 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the bonding authority for the University System of

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Education

16 19-102.

- 17 (c) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, the aggregate
- 18 principal amount of bonds outstanding and the present value of capital lease
- 19 payments, less the amount of any reserve fund or sinking fund requirement
- 20 established for the bonds or capital leases, may not exceed, as of the date of issue of
- 21 the bonds, the following:
- 22 (i) [\$850,000,000] \$875,000,000 for the University System of
- 23 Maryland;
- 24 (ii) \$65,000,000 for Morgan State University;
- 25 (iii) \$45,000,000 for St. Mary's College of Maryland; and
- 26 (iv) \$15,000,000 for Baltimore City Community College.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That: 2 In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the following (1) 3 projects is approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University System of 4 Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of 5 \$12,200,000 for the purposes of financing and refinancing the costs of these projects: 6 (A) University of Maryland, Baltimore (Baltimore City) 7 (i) Renovate Howard Hall Phase VI 8 (B) University System of Maryland College Park (Prince George's 9 County) 10 (i) Renovate Hornbake/McKeldin Libraries 11 (ii) Renovate Taliaferro/Key Hall 12 (C) University of Maryland Eastern Shore (Somerset County) 13 Construct Social Science, Education and Health Science (i) 14 Building. 15 In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the following 16 capital facilities renewal projects is hereby approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University System of Maryland may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in 18 the principal amount of \$12,800,000 for the purposes of financing and refinancing the 19 costs of these facilities renewal projects: University of Maryland, Baltimore (Baltimore City) 20 (A) 21 (i) Facade and Window Upgrade: Medical School Teaching Facility, 22 Phase I 23 (ii) HVAC Upgrade and/or Replacement: School of Pharmacy Facade and Window Upgrade: Medical School Teaching Facility, 24 (iii) 25 Phase II (iv) Elevator Upgrade: Medical School Teaching Facility 26 (B) 27 University of Maryland College Park (Prince George's County) 28 (i) Campus Utilities Infrastructure Improvement, Phased 29 (ii) Building Electro-Mechanical Infrastructure Improvement, 30 Phased (iii) Building Interior Architectural Infrastructure Improvement, 31 32 Phased

12 (3) The bonds issued under the authority of this Act do not create or constitute 13 any indebtedness or obligation of the State or of any political subdivision thereof 14 except the University System of Maryland, and the bonds shall so state on their face. 15 The bonds do not constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General Assembly 16 of Maryland or pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning of Article 17 III, Section 34 of the Constitution of Maryland.				

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 July 1, 2001.
