16 (3) The bonds issued under the authority of this Act do not create or constitute 17 any indebtedness or obligation of the State or of any political subdivision thereof 18 except the University System of Maryland, and the bonds shall so state on their face. 19 The bonds do not constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General Assembly 20 of Maryland or pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning of Article 21 III, Section 34 of the Constitution of Maryland.					
SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
