CHAPTER	
1 AN ACT concerning	
Creation of a State Debt - St. Mary's County - Patuxent River Naval Air Museum and Visitors Center	
FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,000,000  \$500,000 \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of County  Commissioners of St. Mary's County for certain development or improvement  purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a  requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and  providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.	
10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:	
12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the St. Mary's 14 County - Patuxent River Naval Air Museum and Visitors Center Loan of 2001 in a	

15 total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$1,000,000 \$500,000 \$250,000 or (ii) 16 the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This

- 1 loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 2 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 3 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 4 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 5 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 6 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 7 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 8 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer 9 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and 10 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then 11 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the 12 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable 13 architectal and engineers of State Power of County Commissioners of State Power of County Cou
- 13 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of St.
- 14 Mary's County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning,
- $15\,$  design, construction, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the
- 16 buildings and permanent exhibits of the Patuxent River Naval Air Museum and
- 17 Visitors Center, a multiphase, multiyear project, to be located adjacent to the
- 18 Patuxent River Naval Air Station in Lexington Park, Maryland, featuring interactive
- 19 exhibits and hands-on learning experiences for young people, opening a window into
- 20 the high-technology frontiers explored at Patuxent River, and stimulating interest in
- 21 technology careers and education.
- 22 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 23 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 24 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 25 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 26 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 27 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 28 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 29 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 30 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind
- 31 contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any
- 32 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify
- 33 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 34 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2003, to present evidence
- 35 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 36 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of
- 37 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 38 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 39 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the
- 40 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 41 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 42 June 1, 2001.
