- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments**
- 15 FRAUD - HOUSING
- 16 232.
- IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 17 (A) (1) 18 INDICATED.
- "HOUSING AGENCY" MEANS AN AGENCY ESTABLISHED TO 19
- 20 ADMINISTER A HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM UNDER ARTICLE 44A OR ARTICLE
- 21 83B OF THE CODE.
- "HOUSING ASSISTANCE" MEANS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, AS 22
- 23 DEFINED IN ARTICLE 83B § 1-101(E) OF THE CODE, OFFERED FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 24 OBTAINING HOUSING BASED ON NEED UNDER A PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY A
- 25 HOUSING AGENCY AND FINANCED WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY BY FEDERAL, STATE, OR
- 26 LOCAL FUNDS.

- 1 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY MAKE A MISSTATEMENT OF A MATERIAL 2 FACT FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFLUENCING A HOUSING AGENCY REGARDING:
- 3 (1) AN APPLICATION FOR HOUSING ASSISTANCE; OR
- 4 (2) AN ACTION AFFECTING HOUSING ASSISTANCE ALREADY PROVIDED.
- 5 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 6 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR
- 7 IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2001.
