- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the elected members of the Prince George's County Board of Education serving on June 30, 2002 shall terminate on July 1, 2002.
- SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
