However, an individual may not serve for more 22 than 2 consecutive terms. 23 With the approval of the Governor, the State Superintendent may 24 remove any member of a county board appointed under this section for: 25 Immorality; (i) 26 (ii) Misconduct in office; 27 (iii) Incompetency; 28 (iv) Willful neglect of duty; or 29 Failure to attend, without good cause, at least half of the 30 scheduled meetings of the board in any one calendar year.
