CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Medicaid Waiver - Personal Care Services - Individuals with Disabilities -**
3 **Funding**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that general funds appropriated in connection with a
5 certain Medicaid waiver for home- and community-based services for adult
6 individuals with disabilities that remain unexpended by the Department of
7 Human Resources at the end of the fiscal year may not revert to the General
8 Fund and shall remain available for expenditure in the subsequent fiscal year.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal year 2001,
11 general funds appropriated in connection with the Medicaid waiver for home- and
12 community-based services for adult individuals with disabilities under § 15-131 of
13 the Health - General Article that remain unexpended by the Department of Human
14 Resources on June 30, 2001 may not revert to the General Fund and shall remain
15 available for expenditure in the subsequent fiscal year.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 June 1, 2001.
