1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
3	Article - Natural Resources

	(a) Except for a person employed to operate a vessel for a master fishing guide under § 4-701(o), any person who desires to accept direct or indirect consideration for providing services as a fishing guide shall obtain a license.
10	(b) In addition to any license required by this section, a person may not furnish any service as a fishing guide that requires operating a boat or vessel as part of that service without first obtaining appropriate federal licenses to operate a vessel carrying passengers for hire.
	(c) A person who is required to be licensed under this section must have all appropriate federal and State licenses in the person's possession whenever performing services as a fishing guide.
15 16	(d) A commercial fishing guide shall be required to submit reports monthly on forms provided by the Department.
17 18	(e) (1) The Secretary may establish by regulation first aid and safety requirements with which all licensed fishing guides shall comply.
19 20	(2) The Department may suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue a license for failure to comply with the terms of the license.
21 22	(f) The Department may issue a tidal fish license under § 4-701 of this subtitle and a freshwater fishing guide license under § 4-210.1 of this subtitle.
	(G) (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A LIMITED FISHING GUIDE LICENSE THAT IS APPLICABLE ONLY IN ALL WATERS OF THE STATE TO ALLOW A LICENSE HOLDER TO GUIDE ANGLERS IN:
26	(I) <u>ANGLERS IN</u> UP TO 3 BOATS OR VESSELS THAT:
27	1. HAVE 1 OR 2 OCCUPANTS; AND
28	2. <u>IS ARE PROPELLED BY OARS OR PADDLES; OR</u>
29 30	(II) <u>1.</u> UP <u>EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM 2 OF THIS ITEM, UP</u> TO $\frac{3}{4}$ 10 ANGLERS FISHING FROM SHORE <u>OR ON FOOT IN THE WATER; OR</u>

- 1 (2) A PERSON MAY NOT ACCEPT ANY CONSIDERATION FOR SERVICES AS 2 A FISHING GUIDE LICENSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS THE PERSON AND 3 ALL PERSONS BEING GUIDED POSSESS, AS APPLICABLE, AN ANGLER'S LICENSE 4 ISSUED UNDER § 4-604 OF THIS TITLE OR A CHESAPEAKE BAY SPORT FISHING 5 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 4-745 OF THIS TITLE. A RECREATIONAL ANGLER UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A LIMITED 7 FISHING GUIDE IN TIDAL WATERS MAY NOT: 8 CATCH OR POSSESS THE SPECIES OF FISH KNOWN AS THE (I) 9 STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH IN THE TIDAL WATERS DESIGNATED IN § 4-210.1(F) OF 10 THIS SUBTITLE; AND 11 (II)FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH MAY 31, CATCH OR ATTEMPT TO 12 CATCH THE SPECIES OF FISH KNOWN AS THE STRIPED BASS OR ROCKFISH IN 13 SPAWNING AREAS AND RIVERS, INCLUDING ALL WATERS NORTH OF A LINE FROM 14 ABBEY POINT TO WORTON POINT, INCLUDING THE SASSAFRAS RIVER, BOHEMIA 15 RIVER, ELK RIVER, NORTHEAST RIVER, SUSQUEHANNA RIVER, SUSQUEHANNA FLATS, 16 AND THE CHESAPEAKE AND DELAWARE CANAL. THE FEE FOR A LIMITED FISHING GUIDE LICENSE UNDER 17 (H) 18 SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE: 19 (I) FOR A RESIDENT, \$50; AND 20 (II)FOR A NONRESIDENT, \$100. ALL FEES COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS 21 22 SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED FOR MONITORING THE FRESHWATER FISHERY.
- 23 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLICLY REPORT ANNUALLY THE
- 24 AMOUNTS COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25
