- 19 under § 4-701(o), any person who desires to accept direct or indirect consideration for
- 20 providing services as a fishing guide shall obtain a license.
- 21 (b) In addition to any license required by this section, a person may not
- 22 furnish any service as a fishing guide that requires operating a boat or vessel as part
- 23 of that service without first obtaining appropriate federal licenses to operate a vessel
- 24 carrying passengers for hire.
- 25 (c) A person who is required to be licensed under this section must have all
- 26 appropriate federal and State licenses in the person's possession whenever
- 27 performing services as a fishing guide.
