

- 1 (B) (1) THE SEVEN VOTING MEMBERS OF THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD 2 SHALL BE ELECTED AT A GENERAL ELECTION.

- 14 Act shall take effect July 1, 2001, contingent on the taking effect of a redistricting
- 15 plan for the Worcester County Commissioner districts that provides for seven county
- 16 commissioner districts. If a redistricting plan for the seven commissioner districts for
- 17 Worcester County takes effect after July 1, 2001, but before the filing deadline for
- 18 candidates to file for election as Worcester County Commissioners in the November
- 19 2002 general election, Sections 1 and 3 shall take effect on the date that the
- 20 redistricting plan takes effect. If a redistricting plan for the seven commissioner
- 21 districts for Worcester County Commissioners does not take effect by the filing
- 22 deadline for candidates to file for election as Worcester County Commissioners in the
- 23 November 2002 general election, Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall be null and void
- 24 without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly. On or before the
- 25 filing deadline for candidates to file for election as Worcester County Commissioners
- 26 in the November 2002 general election, the Worcester County Commissioners shall
- 27 certify to the Department of Legislative Services whether a redistricting plan for the
- 28 Worcester County Commissioner districts that provides for seven commissioner
- 29 districts took effect before the filing deadline, and, if so, on what date the redistricting
- 30 plan took effect.
- 31 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2 and 4 of this
- 32 Act shall take effect on the failure of Sections 1 and 3 to take effect as provided in
- 33 Section 6 of this Act. If Sections 1 and 3 of this Act take effect, Sections 2 and 4 of this
- 34 Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General
- 35 Assembly.
- 36 SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in
- 37 Sections 6 and 7 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
