- 27 (C) THE BOARD FOR GOOD CAUSE MAY WAIVE THE CONTINUING EDUCATION 28 REQUIREMENT TO PREVENT UNDUE HARDSHIP OR GROSS UNFAIRNESS.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 2001.
