3 FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for a journeyman natural gas fitters
4 license to demonstrate successful completion of certain training courses;
5 requiring an applicant to pass an examination given by the State Board of
6 Plumbing; and generally relating to the qualifications of applicants for a
7 journeyman natural gas fitters license.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

16 12-302.

17 (g) (1) An [application] APPLICANT for a journeyman natural gas fitters
18 license:

19 (I) shall have acquired 3,750 working hours as an apprentice
20 natural gas fitter over a period of at least 2 years; AND

1 (II) SHALL HAVE DEMONSTRATED SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF
2 ~~AN APPROVED~~ A TRAINING COURSE APPROVED BY THE BOARD RELATING TO ~~THE~~
3 ~~INSTALLATION OF NATURAL GAS AS PROVIDED BY THE BOARD~~ SERVICES.

4 (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT
5 FOR A JOURNEYMAN NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE SHALL PASS AN EXAMINATION
6 GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2001.
