13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	12-302. (g) (1) An [application] APPLICANT for a journeyman natural gas fitters license:
19 20	(I) shall have acquired 3,750 working hours as an apprentice natural gas fitter over a period of at least 2 years; AND

- (II)SHALL HAVE DEMONSTRATED SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF
- 2 AN APPROVED A TRAINING COURSE APPROVED BY THE BOARD RELATING TO THE 3 INSTALLATION OF NATURAL GAS AS PROVIDED BY THE BOARD SERVICES.
- EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT
- 5 FOR A JOURNEYMAN NATURAL GAS FITTERS LICENSE SHALL PASS AN EXAMINATION
- 6 GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
