1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Birds - Oriole and Raven**

3 FOR the purpose of making the raven the second State bird of Maryland.

4 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

5 Article - State Government

6 Section 13-302

7 Annotated Code of Maryland

8 (1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article - State Government**

12 13-302.

13 The Baltimore Oriole (*Icterus galbula*) [is] AND THE RAVEN (*CORVUS CORAX*)

14 ARE the State [bird] BIRDS.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

16 October 1, 2001.
