- 2 State Birds Oriole and Raven
- 3 FOR the purpose of making the raven the second State bird of Maryland.
- 4 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 5 Article State Government
- 6 Section 13-302
- 7 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 8 (1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 11 Article State Government
- 12 13-302.
- 13 The Baltimore Oriole (Icterus galbula) [is] AND THE RAVEN (CORVUS CORAX)
- 14 ARE the State [bird] BIRDS.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2001.
