Wicomico County - Bonds - Limitation on Effect of Charter Provision Impairing Obligation to Levy or Collect Taxes

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing Wicomico County to provide security for the payment

5 of principal of and interest on the County's borrowings by creating certain funds

6 or pledging certain funds; prohibiting a charter provision of Wicomico County

7 from impairing or being construed to impair the obligation of the County to levy

8 and collect taxes to pay the principal and interest on certain bonds to which the

9 County has pledged its unlimited taxing power and which are still outstanding

10 on the effective date of the charter provision; and generally relating to security

11 for borrowing in Wicomico County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 (b) For the purpose of providing security for the payment of the principal of

22 and interest on borrowings by Prince George's County, BY WICOMICO COUNTY, or by

1 Anne Arundel County, the borrowing county, by charter provision or by legislative act,

2 (1) may provide for the creation of sinking funds, debt service funds, debt service

3 reserve funds, or other trust funds, including funds held by a corporate trustee,

4 pledged for such payments, (2) may provide that, in the event that sufficient funds for

5 the timely payment of said principal and interest when due are not available or in the

6 event of a default in the payment of said principal or interest, the first general fund

7 revenues of that county received thereafter shall be applied to the payment thereof in

8 amounts sufficient to make such payment when due or to cure such default as the9 case may be, and (3) may pledge any of its revenues to the payment of said principal

10 and interest to the extent provided by said charter provision or legislative act.

11 (c) No charter provision of Prince George's County, WICOMICO COUNTY, or

12 Anne Arundel County shall impair or be construed to impair the obligation of such

 $13\;$ county to levy and collect taxes to provide for the payment when due of principal of

14 and interest on bonds of such county, or bonds guaranteed by such county, to which

15 that county has pledged its unlimited taxing power, and which are outstanding on the

16 effective date of such charter provision.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 June 1, 2001.
