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Fair Pricing for Prescription Drugs - Maximum Allowable Prices

3 FOR the purpose of providing that, based on certain criteria, a manufacturer,

- 4 wholesaler, or retailer may not charge a certain price for a prescription drug sold
- 5 in Maryland; establishing certain maximum pricing criteria for a prescription
- 6 drug sold in this State by a manufacturer; establishing certain maximum
- 7 pricing criteria for a prescription drug sold in this State by a wholesaler;
- 8 establishing certain maximum pricing criteria for a prescription drug sold in
- 9 this State by a retailer; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the

(E) "WHOLESALER" MEANS A PERSON, OTHER THAN A MANUFACTURER, THAT

4 (A) THE MAXIMUM PRICE FOR A PRESCRIPTION DRUG SOLD IN THE STATE BY 5 A MANUFACTURER SHALL BE THE LOWER OF:

6 (1) THE PRICE LISTED IN THE FEDERAL SUPPLY SCHEDULE FOR
7 PHARMACEUTICALS AND DRUGS MAINTAINED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT
8 OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS;

9 (2) THE PRICE LISTED IN THE DRUG FORMULARY MAINTAINED BY THE 10 CANADIAN PROVINCE OF QUEBEC; OR

11 (3) THE PRICE CHARGED IN ANY OTHER STATE.

12 (B) THE MAXIMUM PRICE FOR A PRESCRIPTION SOLD IN THE STATE BY A
13 WHOLESALER IS THE MAXIMUM MANUFACTURER PRICE ESTABLISHED UNDER
14 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION PLUS ANY USUAL AND CUSTOMARY WHOLESALE
15 MARKUP.

16 (C) THE MAXIMUM PRICE FOR A PRESCRIPTION DRUG SOLD IN THIS STATE BY 17 A RETAILER IS THE MAXIMUM WHOLESALE PRICE ESTABLISHED IN SUBSECTION (B) 18 OF THIS SECTION PLUS:

19 (1) ANY USUAL AND CUSTOMARY RETAIL MARKUP; AND

20 (2) A DISPENSING FEE THAT DOES NOT EXCEED THE DISPENSING FEE
21 FOR PRESCRIPTIONS DISPENSED FOR AN ENROLLEE UNDER THE MARYLAND
