15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (a) After September 1, 1971, it shall be unlawful for any employer, employee,

21 corporation, partnership, firm or individual to use welded clip and seat type

22 connections or other welded "clip-type" connectors as temporary fastening devices in

23 any construction involving the use of structural iron or steel.

24 (b) Anyone who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a 25 misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred 26 dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.]

HOUSE BILL 1432

(a) After September 1, 1971, it shall be unlawful for any employer, employee,
3 corporation, partnership, firm or individual to erect any structural steel or iron beams
4 or girders with shear composite studs, other studs or reinforcing shear connectors,
5 provided, however, that nothing herein shall prevent the attachment of these devices
6 after the erection of all structural members or forming or decking of a particular floor
7 or deck level or span of a bridge or area between transverse floor beams is completed.

8 (b) Anyone who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a 9 misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred 10 dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.]

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2001.

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
