- State Personnel Essential Employees Compensation for Work Performed
 During Weather-Related Emergencies
- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain essential State employees who work in
- 5 certain counties during a weather-related emergency are entitled to certain
- 6 compensation for each hour worked during the weather-related emergency;
- 7 defining a certain term; and generally relating to compensation of essential
- 8 State employees who work during weather-related emergencies.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 17 8-203.
- 18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY" MEANS EXTREME
- 19 WEATHER CONDITIONS THAT WOULD EXPOSE STATE EMPLOYEES TO HARM OR
- 20 UNSAFE CONDITIONS.
- 21 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES OF A PRINCIPAL
- 22 DEPARTMENT, OR OF A UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM, IN THE
- 23 EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT WHO ARE REQUIRED TO WORK
- 24 DURING A WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY IN ANY COUNTY:
- 25 (1) IN WHICH STATE OFFICES HAVE BEEN CLOSED DUE TO THE
- 26 WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY; OR

- 1 (2) WHICH HAS BEEN DECLARED ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE
- 2 FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ADMINISTRATION DUE TO THE
- 3 WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY.
- 4 (C) AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION:
- 5 (1) IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE, FOR EACH HOUR WORKED DURING A
- 6 WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY, COMPENSATORY TIME OR ADDITIONAL PAY, AS
- 7 APPROPRIATE, UNDER THE REGULATIONS AND POLICIES CONCERNING WORK
- 8 HOURS AND OVERTIME; AND
- 9 (2) SHALL BE CREDITED WITH 2 HOURS OF WORK TIME FOR EACH HOUR 10 WORKED DURING A WEATHER-RELATED EMERGENCY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 2001.
