- 1 (B) "COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENT GRANT" MEANS A GRANT TO 2 A STUDENT WHO:
- 3 (1) TRANSFERS FROM A COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THE STATE TO AN 4 ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION; AND
- 5 (2) OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A GRANT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
