1 AN ACT concerning

2 Crimes - Physicians - Medical Marijuana - Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that it is a misdemeanor for a physician to
- 4 recommend to a patient the use of marijuana for medical purposes if the patient
- 5 is subsequently charged with the unlawful possession of marijuana; and
- 6 establishing certain penalties.
- 7 BY adding to
- 8 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 9 Section 287D
- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1996 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 15 287D.
- 16 A PHYSICIAN WHO RECOMMENDS TO A PATIENT THE USE OF MARIJUANA FOR
- 17 MEDICAL PURPOSES IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION SHALL BE
- 18 SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE
- 19 THAN \$1,000 OR BOTH, IF THE PATIENT IS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED WITH THE
- 20 UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2001.
