15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Insurance

18 15-904.

19 (A) A carrier may not issue, deliver, or renew a Medicare supplement policy in20 the State unless the Medicare supplement policy complies with this subtitle.

21 (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, A
22 HEALTH INSURER THAT IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES
23 UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY ISSUE MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT POLICIES UNDER THE
24 MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM.

(2) THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT POLICY ISSUED
UNDER THE MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH
REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE FEDERAL OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION
ACT OF 1990 AND ANY SUBSEQUENT RELEVANT FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATIONS.

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(3) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL
 DETERMINE THE ADEQUACY OF THE NETWORK ESTABLISHED BY A HEALTH
 INSURER UNDER THE MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM AS TO THE NUMBER OF
 PROVIDERS, GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION, HOURS OF OPERATION, PROMPTNESS OF
 SERVICE, AND RANGE OF SERVICES.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2001.
