1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Medicare Supplement Policies - Medicare Select Program**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain health insurers to issue Medicare supplement
4 policies under the Medicare Select program; establishing requirements for a
5 Medicare supplement policy issued under the Medicare Select program;
6 requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to make certain
7 determinations about the adequacy of the network established by a health
8 insurer under the Medicare Select program; and generally relating to Medicare
9 supplement policies issued under the Medicare Select program.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Insurance**

18 15-904.

19 (A) A carrier may not issue, deliver, or renew a Medicare supplement policy in
20 the State unless the Medicare supplement policy complies with this subtitle.

1 (B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE, A
2 HEALTH INSURER THAT IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES
3 UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY ISSUE MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT POLICIES UNDER THE
4 MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM.

5 (2) THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT POLICY ISSUED
6 UNDER THE MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH
7 REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE FEDERAL OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION
8 ACT OF 1990 AND ANY SUBSEQUENT RELEVANT FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATIONS.

9 (3) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL
10 DETERMINE THE ADEQUACY OF THE NETWORK ESTABLISHED BY A HEALTH
11 INSURER UNDER THE MEDICARE SELECT PROGRAM AS TO THE NUMBER OF
12 PROVIDERS, GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION, HOURS OF OPERATION, PROMPTNESS OF
13 SERVICE, AND RANGE OF SERVICES.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
15 October 1, 2001.
