BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - State Finance and Procurement** 17 10-501. Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the Board of Public Works 18 19 may grant to an individual erroneously convicted, sentenced, and confined under 20 State law for a crime the individual did not commit an amount commensurate with 21 the actual damages sustained by the individual due to the confinement. 22 In making a grant under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Board
