HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A House Joint Resolution concerning

Emu Awareness Week

3 FOR the purpose of designating April 7 through 15, 2001, as "Emu Awareness Week".

4 WHEREAS, The emu is a gentle, docile bird, native to Australia, and 5 environmentally friendly to raise; and

6 WHEREAS, Emu breeding is currently one of the fastest growing agricultural 7 businesses in the United States, with the State of Maryland home to at least fifty 8 emu farms, some of which have been operating for over 10 years; and

WHEREAS, A growing sector of the State of Maryland's agricultural economy is
supported from the efforts and contributions of the members of the Maryland Emu
Association, who are involved in raising, processing, and marketing emu products;
and

13 WHEREAS, Thirty-eight states, including Maryland, have established emu14 associations; and

WHEREAS, A recent study from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, confirms
that emu meat is lower in fat and cholesterol, and higher in protein and other
nutrients, including iron, when compared to bison, venison, elk, and ostrich; and

18 WHEREAS, Recent federal legislation mandates USDA inspection of emu meat;19 and

20 WHEREAS, An adult emu is almost totally usable, yielding not only red meat, 21 but also a unique, penetrating oil that has been used for relieving arthritis,

22 preventing scars, and treating eczema, and hide that can be used to produce boots,

23 belts, and luggage; now, therefore, be it
