## 1 **Article - Transportation** 2 23-206.2. 3 (b) (1) A motor vehicle owned by an individual who is at least 70 years of age 4 at the time of a scheduled mandatory inspection under this subtitle is exempt from 5 the mandatory inspections required by this subtitle if: [All] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ALL of 6 7 the owners of the motor vehicle are at least 70 years of age at the time of the scheduled mandatory inspection under this subtitle; 9 (ii) The motor vehicle is being driven 5,000 miles or less annually; 10 and 11 (iii) The exemption is not otherwise prohibited by federal law. 12 (2)In order to qualify for an exemption under [paragraph (1) of] this 13 subsection, all owners of the motor vehicle shall certify the following: 14 That [all of] the owners of the motor vehicle [are at least 70] 15 years of age at the time of a scheduled mandatory inspection under this subtitle] 16 SATISFY THE AGE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION; 17 (ii) That the motor vehicle is being driven 5,000 miles or less 18 annually; and 19 (iii) The motor vehicle's odometer reading at the time of the 20 certification. 21 IF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS OWNED IN THE JOINT NAMES OF A HUSBAND 22 AND WIFE, THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY INSPECTIONS 23 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IF: EITHER SPOUSE IS AT LEAST 70 YEARS OF AGE AT THE TIME OF (I) 25 A SCHEDULED MANDATORY INSPECTION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND THE VEHICLE OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR AN EXEMPTION (II)27 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION. The certification required in paragraph (2) of this subsection shall be 28 29 made on a form provided by the Administration. The Administrator may adopt regulations as necessary to administer or 30 31 enforce the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
